<u>H.Res. 562</u> – Rule providing for consideration of <u>S. 585</u> – Dr. Chris Kirkpatrick Whistleblower Protection Act of 2017 (Sen. Johnson – Oversight and Government Reform) (One Hour of debate). The Rules Committee has recommended a closed Rule that provides for one hour of general debate equally divided between the Chair and Ranking Member of the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform. The Rule allows one motion to recommit and waives all points of order against the legislation.

The Rule allows for Suspension Authority on October 12, 2017 and October 13, 2017. Additionally, the Rules Committee rejected three germane amendments from Ranking Member Elijah Cummings that would have made significant improvements to S. 585. **Members are urged to VOTE NO**.

"The federal government's top ethics officer sent a letter to all federal agencies late last week warning that he is 'deeply concerned that the actions of some in government leadership have harmed perceptions about the importance of ethics.' He urged all federal workers to redouble their commitment to acting honorably.... The two-page memo was dated Oct. 5, six days after Tom Price, the secretary of Health and Human Services, announced his resignation after questions surfaced about his use of private and government planes, and inspectors general in at least three other agencies — Interior, Treasury and the Environmental Protection Agency — announced they were conducting their own investigations into plane travel and related issues."
