The House is also expected to begin consideration of [H.R. 2930](#) - Entrepreneur Access to Capital Act (Rep. McHenry – Financial Services) (Subject to a Rule). The House may also consider a Motion to go to Conference on [H.R. 2112](#) - Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Administration, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act (Rep. Kingston – Appropriations).
