- 1) [H.R. 2061](#) – Digital Accountability and Transparency (DATA) Act of 2013, as amended (Rep. Issa – Oversight and Government Reform)
- 2) [H.R. 3343](#) – To amend the District of Columbia Home Rule Act to clarify the rules regarding the determination of the compensation of the Chief Financial Officer of the District of Columbia (Rep. Norton – Oversight and Government Reform)
- 3) [H.R. 3487](#) – To amend the Federal Election Campaign Act to extend through 2018 the authority of the Federal Election Commission to impose civil money penalties on the basis of a schedule of penalties established and published by the Commission, to expand such authority to certain other violations, and for other purposes (Rep. Miller (MI) – House Administration)
- 4) [S.Con.Res. 25](#) – A concurrent resolution authorizing the use of Emancipation Hall in the Capitol Visitor Center for activities associated with the ceremony to award the Congressional Gold Medal to Native American code talkers (Sen. Johnson (SD) – House Administration)
