**H.R. 3299** – Protecting Consumers' Access to Credit Act of 2017 (Rep. McHenry – Financial Services)  
(Subject to a Rule)

The Rule provides for one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the Chair and Ranking Member of the Committee on Financial Services.

**H.R. 3978** – TRID Improvement Act of 2017, Rules Committee Print (Rep. Hill – Financial Services)  
(Subject to a Rule)

1. **H.Res. 129** – Calling on the Department of Defense, other elements of the Federal Government, and foreign governments to intensify efforts to investigate, recover, and identify all missing and unaccounted-for personnel of the United States, as amended (Rep. Johnson (TX) – Foreign Affairs)
2. **H.R. 3542** – Hamas Human Shields Prevention Act, as amended (Rep. Wilson (SC) – Foreign Affairs)
