Flake – Natural Resources/Education and the Workforce) (Subject to a Rule). The House is also expected to begin consideration of [S. 139](#) – FISA Amendments Reauthorization Act of 2017, Rules Committee Print (Rep. Nunes – Intelligence/Judiciary) (Subject to a Rule).
