Hill – Financial Services) (Subject to a Rule) and H.R. 3299 – Protecting Consumers' Access to Credit Act of 2017 (Rep. McHenry – Financial Services) (Subject to a Rule). The House is also expected to begin consideration of H.R. 620 – ADA Education and Reform Act of 2017 (Rep. Poe – Judiciary) (Subject to a Rule).
