The House is expected to consider [S. 2155](#) – Economic Growth, Regulatory Relief, and Consumer Protection Act (Sen. Crapo – Financial Services) (Subject to a Rule) and [S. 204](#) – Trickett Wendler, Frank Mongiello, Jordan McLinn, and Matthew Bellina Right to Try Act (Sen. Johnson – Energy and Commerce) (Subject to a Rule). The House is also expected to consider bills listed for consideration under suspension of the Rules.

Lastly, the House is expected to begin consideration of [H.R. 5515](#) – National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2019 (Rep. Thornberry – Armed Services) (Subject to a Rule). Votes on amendments and final passage will occur later in the week.

"A sweeping farm bill failed in the House on Friday in a blow to GOP leaders who were unable to placate conservative lawmakers demanding commitments on immigration. The House leadership put the bill on the floor gambling it would pass... But their gamble failed. The vote was 213 to 198, with 30 Republicans joining 183 Democrats in defeating the bill. The outcome exposed what is becoming an all-out war within the House GOP over immigration, a divisive fight the Republicans did not want to have heading into midterm elections in November that will decide control of Congress. The bill's collapse also highlight the splits within the GOP conference that have bedeviled House Speaker Paul D. Ryan (R-Wis.) and will be certain to dog the top lieutenants in line to replace him, Majority Leader Kevin McCarthy (R-Calif.) and Majority Whip Steve Scalise (R-La.)."
