Bishop (MI) – Ways and Means) (Subject to a Rule), [H.R. 5735](#) – Transitional Housing for Recovery in Viable Environments Demonstration Program Act (Rep. Barr – Financial Services) (Subject to a Rule), and [H.R. 2851](#) – Stop Importation and Trafficking of Synthetic Analogues Act of 2017 (Rep. Katko – Energy and Commerce) (Subject to a Rule). Members are advised that the House is only expected to consider the Rule for these three bills tomorrow.
