Complete Consideration of H.R. 1585 – Violence Against Women Reauthorization Act of 2019 (Rep. Bass – Judiciary)

<u>S.J.Res. 7</u> – To direct the removal of United States Armed Forces from hostilities in the Republic of Yemen that have not been authorized by Congress (Sen. Sanders – Foreign Affairs)

The Rule, which was adopted yesterday, provides for one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the Chair and Ranking Member of the Foreign Affairs Committee.
