After suspension debate, the House will resume consideration of amendments to H.R. 3055, beginning with Division E (Transportation and Housing and Urban Development). Members should be prepared to offer their amendment at the appropriate time tomorrow.

- 1. H.R. 2109 BRAVE Act (Rep. Rice (NY) Veterans' Affairs)
- 2. <u>H.R. 2196</u> To amend title 38, United States Code, to reduce the credit hour requirement for the Edith Nourse Rogers STEM Scholarship program of the Department of Veterans Affairs (Rep. Barr Veterans' Affairs)

Continue Consideration of <u>H.R. 3055</u> – Commerce, Justice, Science, Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Administration, Interior, Environment, Military Construction, Veterans Affairs, Transportation, and Housing and Urban Development Appropriations Act, 2020 (Rep. Serrano – Appropriations)

The Rule, which was adopted last week, allows for no further general debate, made in order 290 amendments, and allows for amendments to be offered en bloc. A full list of amendments can be found <u>here</u>.

As of Friday, the House has completed amendment consideration through Division D (Military Construction and Veterans Affairs).
